## OUR VISION

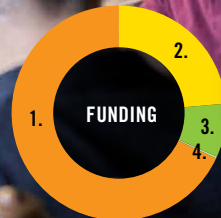

## THE YEAR AHEAD 2026

**Borrow a Researcher** – schools and workplaces across the country can book a researcher for a visit – either in person or online.

**Science & Society Conference** – Sweden's meeting place for researchers, civil society and policymakers. This year's theme is preparedness, resilience and sustainability.

**Almedalen Week** – at our Arena for Research and Democracy, research, practice and politics meet in open discussions on current societal issues.

**Frihamnsdagarna** – we explore the relationship between research and society at West Sweden's democracy festival.

**ForskarFredag (Researchers' Night)** – experiments, activities and dialogue with researchers in 30 locations during Sweden's most widespread science festival. This year marks our 20th anniversary!

**Researchers' Grand Prix** – researchers from across the country compete for a place in a spectacular final, where we determine who is the best in Sweden at presenting their research – in just four minutes!

**Forum for Science Communication** – the largest Nordic conference for everyone who works with, or is interested in, science communication.
